About The Cost of Attendance

Each college or university determines an estimate of how much it will cost for a student to attend their school. This is known as the Cost of Attendance (COA). The COA takes into consideration tuition and fees, room and board and an allowance for personal, transportation and miscellaneous expenses. **Keep in mind that you will not be paying this total amount directly to the school.**
