

How to Use this Guide

This guide is meant to offer advice on courses to take in the first year of college in order to progress towards a degree for new students at UNC Asheville, or their advisors. Completing a degree will require completion of both the Integrative Liberal Studies (ILS) curriculum as well as major requirements set by the department you choose to declare a major in.

Please [read the general plan first](#). This has information on 100-level requirements for ILS. Then you may review the section on your intended major. Designing your first-year plan will likely consist of beginning with the recommendations under your major, and then adding any and all ILS courses that you feel comfortable taking in your first year.

Art History

- Art History requires two sequences of introductory courses. One of these is comprised of ARTH 201: Introduction to Art History I (3) and ARTH 202: Introduction to Art History II (3).
- ARTH 201 is a fall course, and 202 is a spring course.
- If ARTH 201 and 202 are full, students can take other 200 or 300 level ARTH courses without prerequisites and fulfill the introductory sequence later.
- Art History majors also take two 100-level studio art classes. This includes ART 100: Two-Dimensional Design (3), and one course selected from ART 101: Drawing I (3) or ART 102: Life Drawing I (3).
- Art History majors do not need to take their studio art classes in the first year. In fact, to save room for studio art majors, they should wait until their second or third year.
