

# ARTS Outcomes Assessment

## Moodle Help Sheet

### Art Presentation

- At the beginning of the assessment the instructor will present a piece of art for the purpose of individual student response, analysis, and critique.
- Before answering questions on the assessment form, be sure to observe the art fully. If it is to be read—read the entire piece before responding. If it is to be watched—watch the entire piece before responding. Etc.
- The instructor will not comment on the art, nor prepare you with any specific background information on the piece of art.
- This is a quiet single-student observation and evaluation of the art, so class discussions of the art and perceptions of the art is not appropriate.
- This assessment is not graded and the instructor will use a numbering system for the assessment instrument to keep individual names from appearing on the assessment instrument, allowing anonymity in the responses. Please be assured that your answers to the questions will not affect your course grade. We want you to feel free to provide your honest perceptions of the arts and evaluation of the art piece presented.

### Moodle Login

- Faculty and Staff will login using your UNCA domain password which in most cases will be the same as your OnePort login.
- Students will login using your OnePort username/password combination.
- Users logging on for the first time should use their OnePort username/password combination.
- If you do not remember your OnePort password, you may change your password using the UNC Asheville Change Password Utility which can be accessed from the Moodle Login page.

### Completing the Assessment

- You must answer every question as you scroll through the Assessment. The text blocks for the five short essay questions are quite large.
- After pressing the submit button you should be taken to the confirmation page. If you are not taken to the confirmation page please read error message, complete skipped questions, and press the submit button. Thank you!
