Course Objective: The goal of this class is to examine art's function to expose and reconcile an individual's relationship to society. Most art is heavily concerned with this theme, and a favorite vehicle of writers, filmmakers, and musicians to express this is the conflict between the outsider and the insider. We are going to examine these ideas in the culture of Japan in particular -- not only because it has a markedly different history, but also because of the way it has absorbed, reconfigured, and retransmitted the archetypes and themes of our own culture.

We will examine a traditional Japanese aesthetic (*wabi-sabi*), and then take a look at Modern (i.e. 20th and 21st century) Japanese artists in literature, film, visual art, and music to see how they attempt to solve the problem of belonging to the group while staying outside of the mainstream.

Attendance and Participation:

A major part of your grade is going to be based on participation – this means that you should be in class, you should prepare by reading the assigned texts, and you should speak up and offer your opinions in class. You are allowed three unexcused absences in a one semester class, and every subsequent unexcused absence will result in a drop of half a letter grade.
