Course Description, Objectives, Requirements, Evaluation, and Tentative Syllabus

Description:

Introduction to the study of the French language and culture through classroom and web-lab instruction. For elementary level, first and second semester, and those referred by placement test or departmental evaluation. This sequence satisfies the foreign language integrative liberal studies requirements at UNCA.

Objectives:

1. The student will learn to speak and understand, read and write basic elementary French through intensive class work, with textbook c-d rom, web exercises and activities, films and internet resources.
2. The student will study the people of France and francophone areas, including their daily customs, cultural values and *mentalité*, and will especially focus on the diversity of the francophone world, past and present, in the context of the liberal arts.

Requirements:

Attendance and participation are required at each class meeting because of intensive oral and aural classroom practice and assignments and preparation of daily exercises for written, oral, and aural comprehension. Text and materials: Cathy Pons' and Albert Valdman's *Chez nous*, 3rd edition (Prentice-Hall), with web ct is required. Tests and quizzes are given on schedule over material covered in class.

Evaluation:

The final grade is an average of daily work, web lab exercises, chapter quizzes, and chapter exams. The lowest homework, quiz, and exam grade will be dropped from the average:
