Closing Information for Breaks

For safety and security reasons, the residence halls are closed during break periods (except for Fall Break). Residential Education staff will not be consistently available during breaks, and Campus Police provides minimum coverage. The Dining Hall will be closed, and availability of student services will be reduced. Students do not need to take their belongings out of their rooms during breaks, but they will not have access to their rooms when residence halls are closed.
