1. "I received the profoundest impression of possibility that there could be powerful mental processes which nevertheless remain hidden from the consciousness of man."
2. "The goal of psychoanalysis is to strengthen the ego, to make it more independent of the super-ego, to widen its field of perception and enlarge its organization, so that it can appropriate fresh portions of the id. Where id was, there ego shall be."
3. "We are making progress. In the middle ages they would have burnt me; nowadays they are content with burning my books."
4. "The great question that has never been answered and which I have not yet been able to answer, despite my thirty years of research into the feminine soul, is 'what does a woman want'?"
